The National Treasury has issued the following addendum to the Tender for Development of a Public Investment Management Information System (PIMIS) following requests from interested bidders.

1.	Page 19 states "All copies that require certification to be certified by a Commissioner of Oaths or a Notary Public for Foreign Firms".	Can be done by a Notary Public in the country of origin or by Commissioner of Oaths in Kenya
	Question: When foreign firms are considered the certification is done by the Notary Public in Kenya or in the country of origin?	
2.	Clause 20.0 states "The successful service provider is expected to provide evidence of three (3) PIM Information Systems that they have developed within the last five (5) years by sponsoring/facilitating five (5) officers to visit the field sites where the systems were developed."	To be done at post award stage However, the modality of how to perform the activity will be determined at a later stage.
	Question: This activity is expected to be performed at the pre-award stage or at the initial stage of the assignment? If at the pre-award stage, is it acceptable to conduct systems demonstration online?	
3.	In case of Joint Venture/Consortium Bid are all companies required to submit

	To allow shipment of original documents by foreign firms, we would greatly appreciate you considering providing time extension from the day of response to clarifications.	
	In view of the complexity associated with it and also the need to ensure the availability of the requested hardware, we would like to kindly ask for an extension of two weeks in the deadline for submitting proposals, thus giving us the conditions to be able to deliver the best possible proposal to you.	
5.	ITT Clause Number 2.20.1: According to the Technical Mandatory Criteria, some of the documents should be certified by the Kenyan mission. In our case, the listed documents are already certified by the State Government authority of the country of origin. Could you please confirm that this is acceptable and there is no further need to certify them at the Kenyan mission?	They shall be further certified by the Kenyan mission or Notary Public in the country of origin or by Commissioner of Oaths in Kenya. The State Government Authority shall forward the certified copies to the Kenyan mission for authentication.
6.	Minimum Server technical specifications: The technical specifications provided in this section are not sufficient for the number of concurrent users indicated in the TOR. Could you please confirm that we are allowed to make modifications to those specifications in order to meet the expected number of concurrent users?	The specifications provided are bear minimum. The bidder proposal should meet the minimum specifications and also be able to support the system proposed

8.	Should any Database Software (DBMS) be licensed and included in the proposal or do you already have software licensed for this purpose? 12.	In the tender document, we are supposed to supply a "Support Helpdesk", what exactly are the tasks that are expected to be accomplished? What level of support is needed?	All support needed by the users
13.	The document also states, "To incorporate Electronic Document Management System (EDMS) module into PIM system". Does this mean that this EDMS system already exists and that interconnection is necessary or, on the other hand, it is necessary to develop the EDMS system from scratch?	EDMS does not exist. It will be developed as a module in PIMIS
14.	Are travel expenses outside of Nairobi (for training) supported by the National Treasury separately or should they be included in the proposal? If they are to be considered, is it possible to estimate how many trips and to which places are they foreseen?	The bidder to provide travel expenses for their facilitators. The number of trips cannot be ascertained at this point in time but there shall be trips within the country at all points of use.
15.	"i. System user training (150 users) in workshop for not less than 7 days". Does this mean there are 7 days in total or 7 days for each workshop?	7 days for each workshop for Three (3) workshops
