

See page 20 of the Tender Document Clause 2.20.1  All certifications copies to be undertaken by a Commissioner of Oaths or equivalent for Foreign Bidders.
	If a consortium partner is a foreign company, TNT expects it to be certified by the Kenyan mission in the country of origin or respective mission in Kenya. Due to Covid-19 pandemic, Kenyan missions are not functioning in some countries. In such a circumstance, will that be acceptable if attested by Commission of Oaths or equivalent (Notary Public) in the country of origin?	For foreign companies, where the Kenyan Missions are closed, the other option of authentication by the bidders' country mission in Kenya is still viable.
