- The Government of Kenya (GoK) has received Program Preparatory Advance (PPA) from the World Bank toward the cost of the Financing Locally-Led Climate Action Program (FLLoCA), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Supply & Delivery of Heavy Duty Utility Passenger
- 2. The National Treasury (the Client), through the Program Implementation Unit now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for Supply & Delivery of Heavy Duty Utility Passenger Vehicles as given below; Heavy Duty Utility Passenger Vehicles 4x4, L.W.B.,2701-3000cc, Diesel. Quantity Three (3No).

Bidders MUST quote for all the quantities. Bidders quoting for less quantities will be considered non-responsive and such bids will be rejected. Bidders MUST demonstrate that they have successfully completed at least three contracts of similar goods in the past 3 years by providing proof or completion certificates.

Final delivery point for the goods is at the Kenya Reinsurance Plaza, 7th Floor within 30 days or earlier following the date of contract effectiveness.
